

## For an iPhone:

Access settings and tap control center. 2 Tap customize controls and add "do not disturb while driving" (pictured). 3 Swipe to access the control center. 4 Tap the car button to turn on

## For Android:

- Open the Play Store.
  - Download an
- app that enables "do not disturb while driving" (pictured).
- 3 Follow app instructions, as settings may vary.
