Eureka! In the 1930s, prospectors would find gold in the streams. Now, panning for gold is for fun instead of trying to strike it rich!

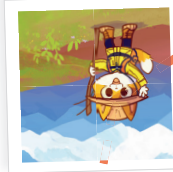
