



## **Caverns**

### Stalactites and Stalagmites

Some National Parks have caverns or caves you can explore. A cave is a large opening in the ground, a hill, or a cliff. Often you will see formations from the ceiling and on the floor of a cave. These are from water droplets containing minerals dripping slowly over time. They are called **stalactites** (from the ceiling) and stalagmites (on the floor). KeeKee remembers
