The "hula" is a Polynesian style dance, where the dance tells a story.

When people greet each other in Hawaii, they say 'Aloha' (ah-LOW-ha) and kiss on the cheek.

Because of its warm, tropical climate, they grow coffee, macadamia nuts, pineapples, and sugarcane in Hawaii!

A Luau is a traditional Hawaiian meal where you sit on the floor on mats and have food such as salmon, kalua pork, poi, sweet potatoes, coconuts, and bananas. They decorate with the garlands of flowers (the lei), listen to Hawaiian music, and dance.

In Hawaii, people often wear 'aloha wear' - fun, bright clothing with floral prints.



Hawaii consists of 137 islands formed by volcanoes. But there are six main islands. You can see them on the map.
