Washington Monument National Mall

Built to honor the 1st President of the US, George Washington. The shape is called an obelisk.



Dinosaur Bones

National Museum of Natural History

Apollo 11 Command Module

National Air & Space Museum

Where the astronauts lived during the first moon landing mission.



White House National Mall

This is where the President of the United States lives and works.



Paddle Boat Rental


Tidal Basin
